PA Connecting Communities (PACC) offers unique tailored activities, all activities not only prohibit skill regression they enhance social skill development. Students' IEP goals are targeted and monitored and reported to the school. The school districts will contract with PACC to provide the services. No fee is invoiced to the family. 1 to 1 staff ratio

WHY PACC's ESY PROGRAM?

PACC offers a variety of learning experiences according to the goals established in the IEP. A meet and greet with student, family and school officials will determine your ESY program. One option of ESY activities is provided at the Connecting Me Home where life skills are reinforced and developed. The home is in Greentree in a residential area near a bus stop. The house is fully equipped with a yard. A calendar of activities is provided for registration.

PACC also offers a Community Inclusion option where employment readiness is addressed, banking, visits to local universities, CCAC and technical schools are explored. Travel training is also an area of focus. Learning opportunities are offered AM and PM for your convenience.

You may choose a combination of activities or design your own plan with the student, Transition staff and approved school goals. We want to address your individual goals and needs.

Fridays will provide field trip activities such as a tour of the Giant Eagles to see all their operations, A Bank, Bowling league, pizza and movie, Carnegie Libraries and museum. The student is given the opportunity to socialize, develop new friendships and learn communication skills. They will be part of the planning committee.
